<u>Library Circulation Trends:</u> At the last meeting I was asked about library circulation trends and how they were being affected by the growth of digital items, like ebooks. As you see on the chart and graphs included in your packet, the use of digital items continues to increase and is becoming a significant percentage of items checked out.

Of great concern is the continued decline in the number of items being checked out. Between 2014 and 2017, circulation for Winnefox libraries dropped by 14.5% and increase in Overdrive use has not offset that decline. Directors will be discussing this issue in our county LAC meetings.

<u>Library Director News:</u> Laura Fultz has left Berlin and Chris Kalupa has been hired as the new director.

Staff News: One of our drivers, John Neal, has left.
