System News: In an effort to better communicate both with system staff and member library staff, there have been two changes. One, Winnefox hosts a staff meeting for all 14 full-time staff every other week. It is an opportunity for staff to share projects they have been working on and for Administration to communicate changes in policies or procedures. Two, Angela Schneider has begun to put together a weekly newsletter summarizing events and updates from the past week. Winnie's Roundup is sent to all member library staff and directs individuals to important emails they might have missed in their inbox.

Winnefox has hired a new ILL page and sorter, Christine Pascarella.

Winnefox will be hosting its Annual Meeting with all member library directors on Tuesday January 23 at the Elisha D. Smith Library in Menasha.

<u>Library News:</u> Heidi Marshall has been hired as the new Packwaukee Library Director. She takes over from Carol Deer who retired in October.

Ripon Public Library is the most recent Winnefox Library to have its historical digital collection added to Recollection Wisconsin's site. Ripon's collection includes yearbooks, newspapers, and genealogy notebooks and joins 13 other Winnefox library collections on Recollection Wisconsin's site.

As of this month all Winnefox libraries, who were previously on Spectrum internet, have now been moved to TEACH internet. This has been a multi-year process working with a number of agencies and it is a relief to have this project completed.

<u>State News:</u> Librarians, trustees, and other supporters will be heading down to Madison on Tuesday February 6, 2023. This is a chance to thank the legislature for their support of libraries and advocate for continued support.
